



# **EXCELLENCE IN SERVICE AWARD**

## **AWARD CRITERIA**

### **PURPOSE**

In 2007, the TXTA Safety Management Council Executive Committee decided to establish an award to honor an individual who best exemplifies the willing dedication to be of service to the Motor Transportation Industry, the TXTA Safety Management Council, his or her Company and the motoring public. The recipient is one who has demonstrated the qualities of interest, enthusiasm and leadership in achieving these multiple goals.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Nominee must be a member of TXTA and the TXTA Safety Management Council. Nominee can be either employed full time or retired from a member company. They must have served the Motor Transportation Industries and the TXTA Safety Management Council continuously for a minimum of seven (7) years. This includes members from Motor Carriers, Allied companies and Law and Regulatory enforcement.

In addition, all nominees must comply with the following:

1. Nominee must be domiciled in Texas.
2. Previous award winners may not again be nominated.

Nominations, which are unsuccessful in any given year, may be resubmitted the following year by bringing the required information up to date as of the time of re-submission.

### **BASIS FOR THE AWARD**

Judging of nominations shall be based upon the professional qualifications of the nominee, success in advancing the cause of TXTA, the TXTA Safety Management Council and highway and industrial safety. The nominee shall also be judged on his/her work and leadership in activities of TXTA and the TXTA Safety Management Council and/or other organizations of safety professionals in which the nominee holds active membership.
