TXTA TRUCK SAFETY CONTEST

Contest Rules:

- Company must be a member of TXTA.
- Contest winners will be determined by lowest Accident Frequency Rate in each mileage classification for the year 2023. The formula for determining Accident Frequency is:

Number of accidents X 1,000,000 Vehicle miles

- Only those accidents required by DOT to be recordable as defined in Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 390.5 will be counted in determining a company's Accident Frequency Rate. Accidents that have been ruled non-preventable through FMCSA's Crash Preventability Determination Program do not need to be counted. Final ruling must have been made by contest deadline date, March 1, 2024.
- For TXTA member carriers operating interstate, contest figures should only reflect the mileage and accidents occurring in Texas.
- Companies may submit entry forms for different operating divisions within their company but may not enter additional cities within the same operating division.
- Winners in each Mileage Classification will be audited by a TXTA Safety Management Council Representative.
- <u>Supporting documentation must be provided</u>. <u>Supporting documentation should include items</u> <u>such as IFTA reports, accident registers, SMS scores, etc...</u>
