ABOUT ELC

In 1932, Texas Trucking Association was founded to protect the collective interest of the trucking industry and is dedicated to educating members and equipping them with essential tools to operate successful businesses. To further that commitment, in 2013 TXTA created the Emerging Leaders Council (ELC)—promoting the next generation of industry leaders. ELC provides an opportunity for members to network and learn through interactive trainings and immersive advocacy experiences ensuring that the industry has a strong leadership base to call on. Previous ELC classes have included executives, business owners, sales teams, financial analysts and a variety of other trucking positions within the industry.

RETURN ON INVESTMENT

The ELC is comprised of up-and-coming leaders from TXTA and SMA member companies. During the ELC class term, members develop business relationships and friendships, increase their knowledge of trucking, legislative, regulatory and political issues, as well as establish themselves as future leaders within the association.

NOMINATIONS

Nominations for the ELC Class of 2028 will be accepted through April 22 and accepted nominees will be notified by May 8. Nominations are reviewed by current and past ELC officers, TXTA chairman and TXTA president and CEO. Membership will be capped at 25 members. The ratio of carrier to allied members should remain 60:40 or greater in favor of carrier members.

The ELC membership fee is \$500 per year (\$1,000 total). This membership fee helps to offset the cost of guest speakers as well as group outings and meals.

ELC members are required to attend a set number of meetings each year to be determined at the start of each class to maintain membership status. ELC graduates may continue to attend all ELC meetings and social outings (costs may apply), but will not be able to vote in ELC officer elections.

The Class of 2028 will be introduced at TXTA Annual Conference, July 29–July 31, 2026, at J.W. Marriott San Antonio Hill Country Resort & Spa. ELC members will meet as a group during annual conference on July 29 and July 30.
